o Germs! Germs! By Bobbi Katz

Sensory Bags

- o Baby oil gel
- o Sandwich bag
- o Tape
- o Blue buttons
- o Dry erase marker

Procedures:

Reading a book: Have children to gather to listen and look at the book. Making sure that the reader engages the children by describing what they are seeing and allowing the children to touch the pictures (if they are able to).

<u>Sensory Bags:</u> Place in a bag baby oil gel and buttons. Seal bag and draw with a dry erase marker a shape and tape bag to the floor or table. Demonstrate that you want children to put all the buttons in the shape. If they are not able to grasp this concept, still show them how to do this and then have them to play with the bag.

Puppet Play: Talk with children about what is a germ and ways we can prevent spreading germs. Allow children to touch the puppets and ask questions to the puppets.
