- Flashcards
- Music Time
- Reading a Book on Numbers

Resources and materials needed:

Music Time

- Electronic Devices (iPad, cell phones, tablets)
- Downloaded children's music
- Plastic music instruments, pots, pans

Flashcards:

- Find pictures of items that start with the letter "K" and laminate the pictures

Reading a Book: (Suggestions)

- One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish by Dr. Seuss

Procedures:

Flashcard: Pre make laminated cards with items that start with the letter "K" (i.e. kite, kitchen, etc) and start with the sound of "K" then say the word.

Music Time: On electronic device play children's music and have children to pretend to play instruments, pots, and pans and singing with the songs.

Reading a Book: Have children to gather to listen and look at the book. Making sure that the reader engages the children by describing what they are seeing and allowing the children to touch the pictures (if they are able to).

Activity:

1. Nursery Rhymes Time
2. Puppet Play
3. Toy Car Game

Resources and materials needed:

Toy Car Game

- Cardboard
- Labels
- Markers
- Toy cars (18)

Musical Chairs

- Music player with different nursery rhymes
- Chairs

Puppet Play

- Animal puppets

Procedures:

Musical Chairs Play CD/ Music Player that has nursery rhyme music. If children are mobile have them to dance to the songs and sing. This is an opportunity for teachers to be silly with the children.

Puppet Play: Have children to sit in a circle and have puppets talk with children about staying warm in the winter. Allow children to touch the puppets and ask questions to the puppets.

Toy Car Game: Take cardboard and marker and draw lines like a parking lot on the cardboard. Then number the spaces up to 18. Then take the labels and number them 1 to 18 and then place



them on the cars. Demonstrate to the children how to place the car in the correct space and then have the children to repeat the action

Activity:

1. Drum Circle
2. Reading a Book about Mittens
3. Octagon Hop

Resources and materials needed:

Drum Circle

- Pots
- Pans
- Plastic spoons

Reading a Book:

- The Missing Mittens Mystery by Stephen Kellogg

Octagon Hop

- Laminated colorful octagons
- Painter's Tape

Procedures:

Drum Circle: Place pots and pans around the children or a semi-circle on the floor give children a plastic spoon and have them to bang on the pots and pans.

Reading a Book: Have children to gather to listen and look at the book. Making sure that the reader engages the children by describing what they are seeing and allowing the children to touch the pictures (if they are able to).

Octagon Hop: Teacher's will laminate different color octagons and tape them to the floor. Teachers will call out a color and the children will go to that color octagon. If they go to the wrong octagon have them to do 18 jumping jacks and go to the correct color.
