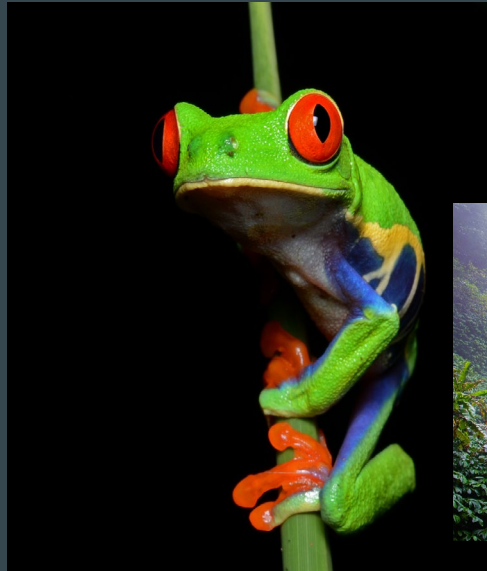

Bonobo of the Congo Basin

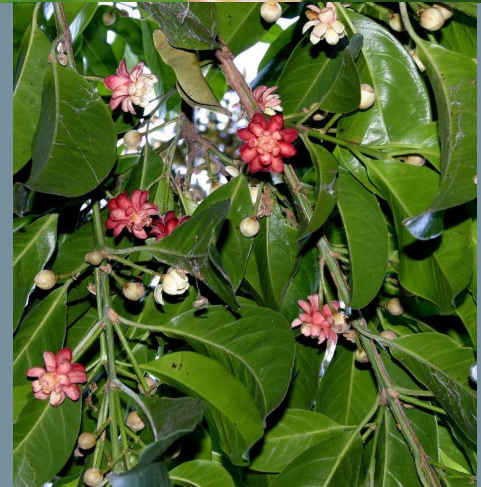

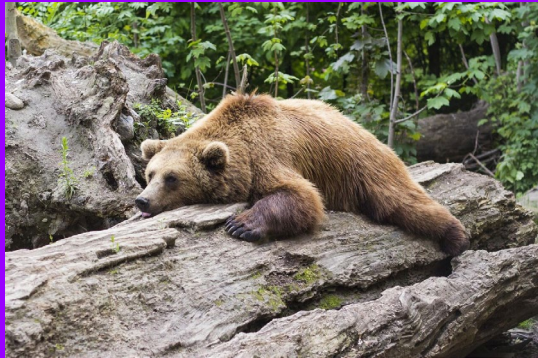
Indochinese Tiger *The Cardamom Mountains Rainforest*
