Pumpkins grow in the fall. There are over 100 different types of pumpkins.

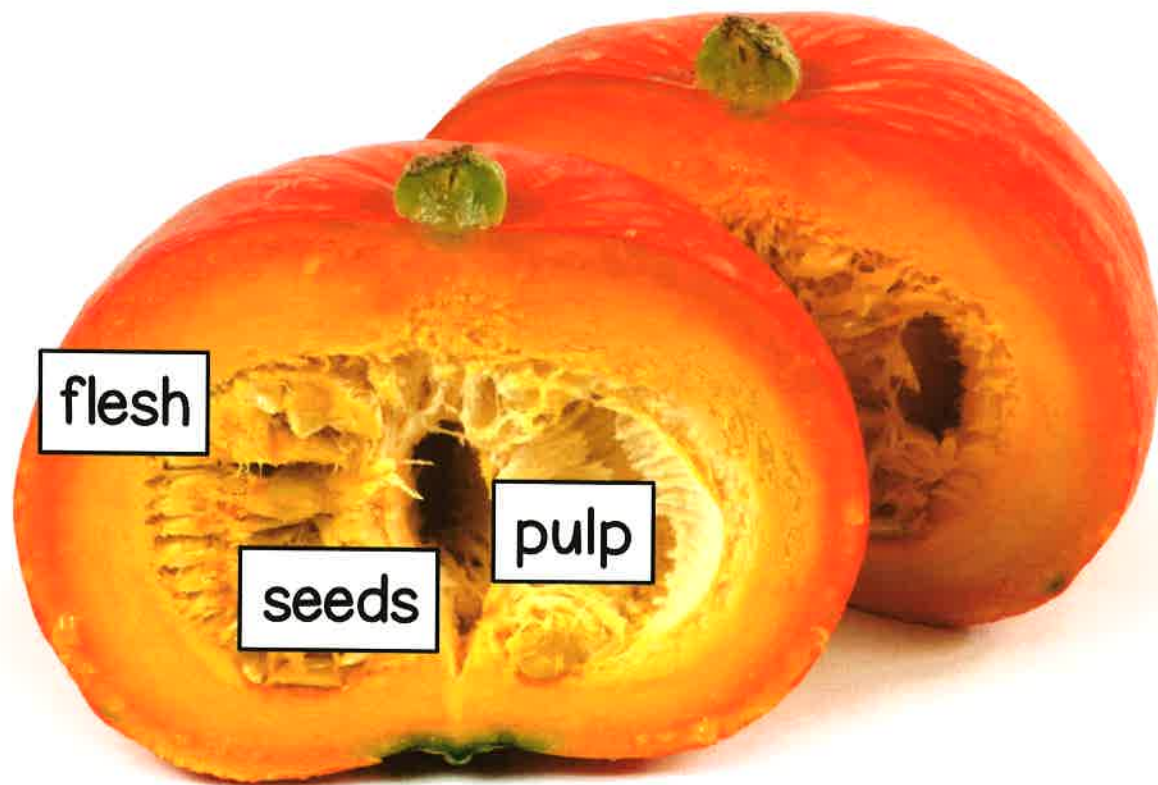


Most pumpkins are orange but they can also be white, yellow, red or even gray.

about the inside?



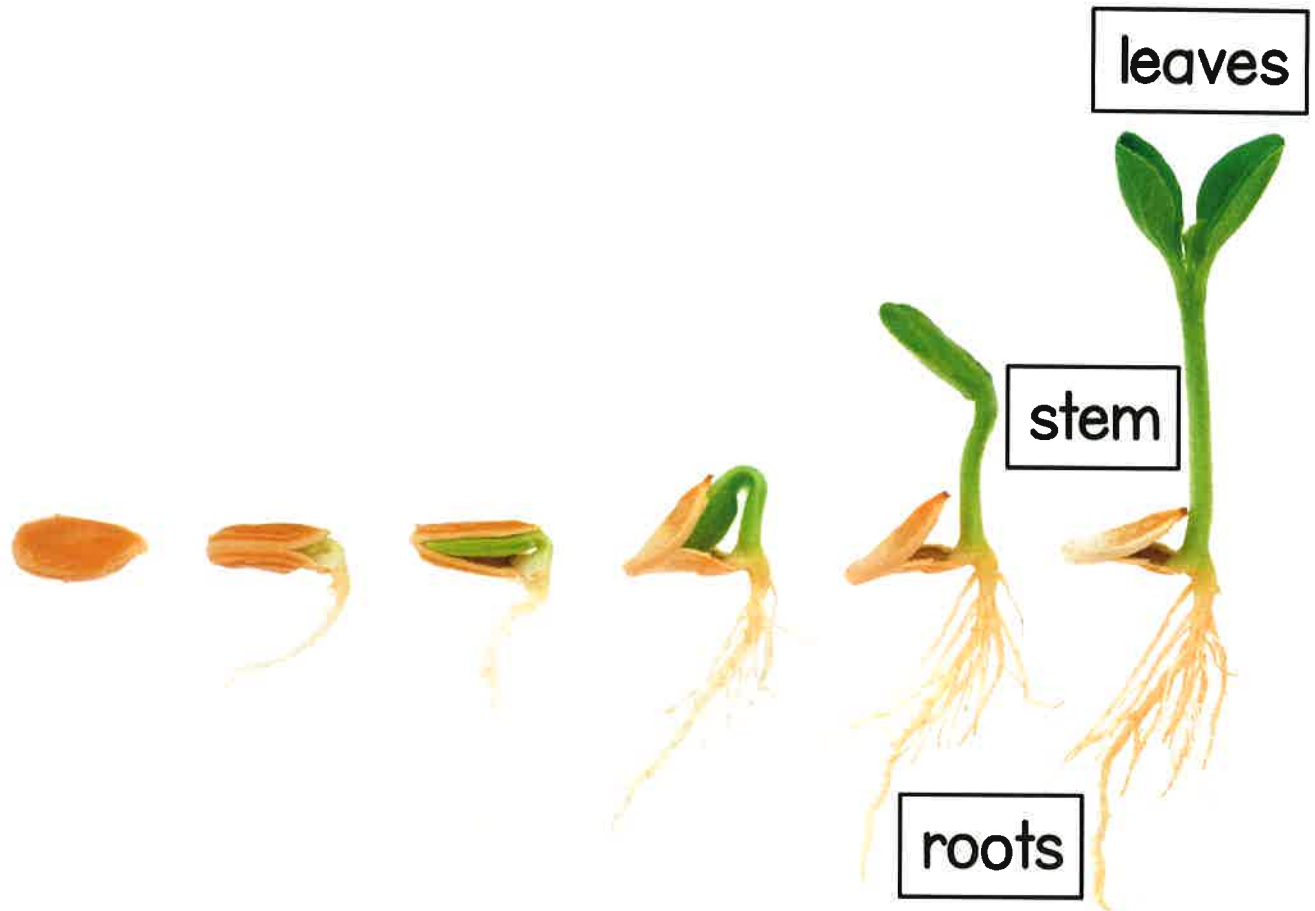
Under the skin is a layer of flesh.

In the middle, you will find seeds and pulp.



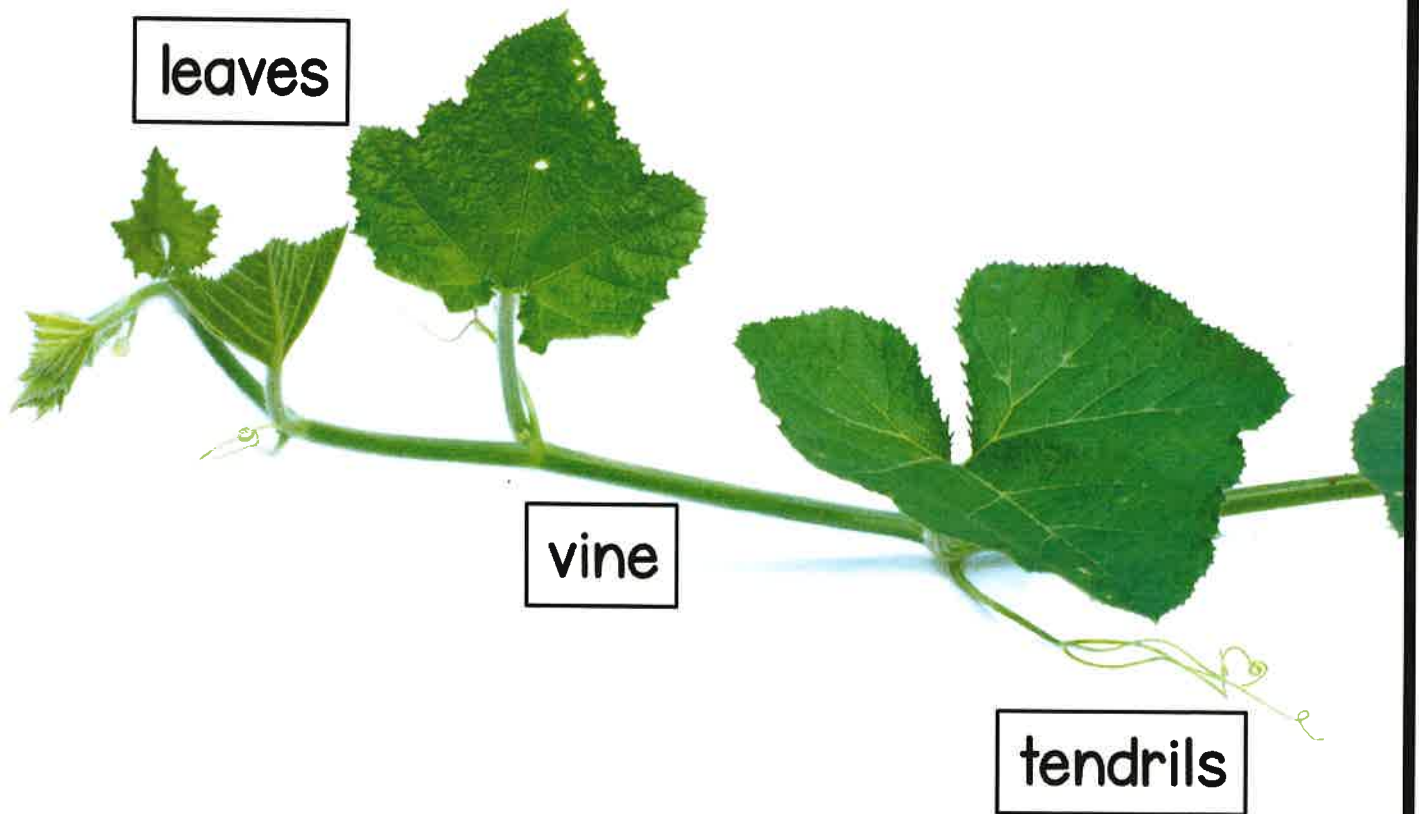
Some people like to
