Activities

Magical Milk project will allow the children to see how liquid reacts to each other while creating beautiful art. Put in a bowl 1 cup of milk, then add dots of food coloring to the milk. Dip the Q-Tip into the dish soap and then place the tip in the milk to see the reaction and the colors changing. Ask the children during this time what they observed and what they think will happen next.

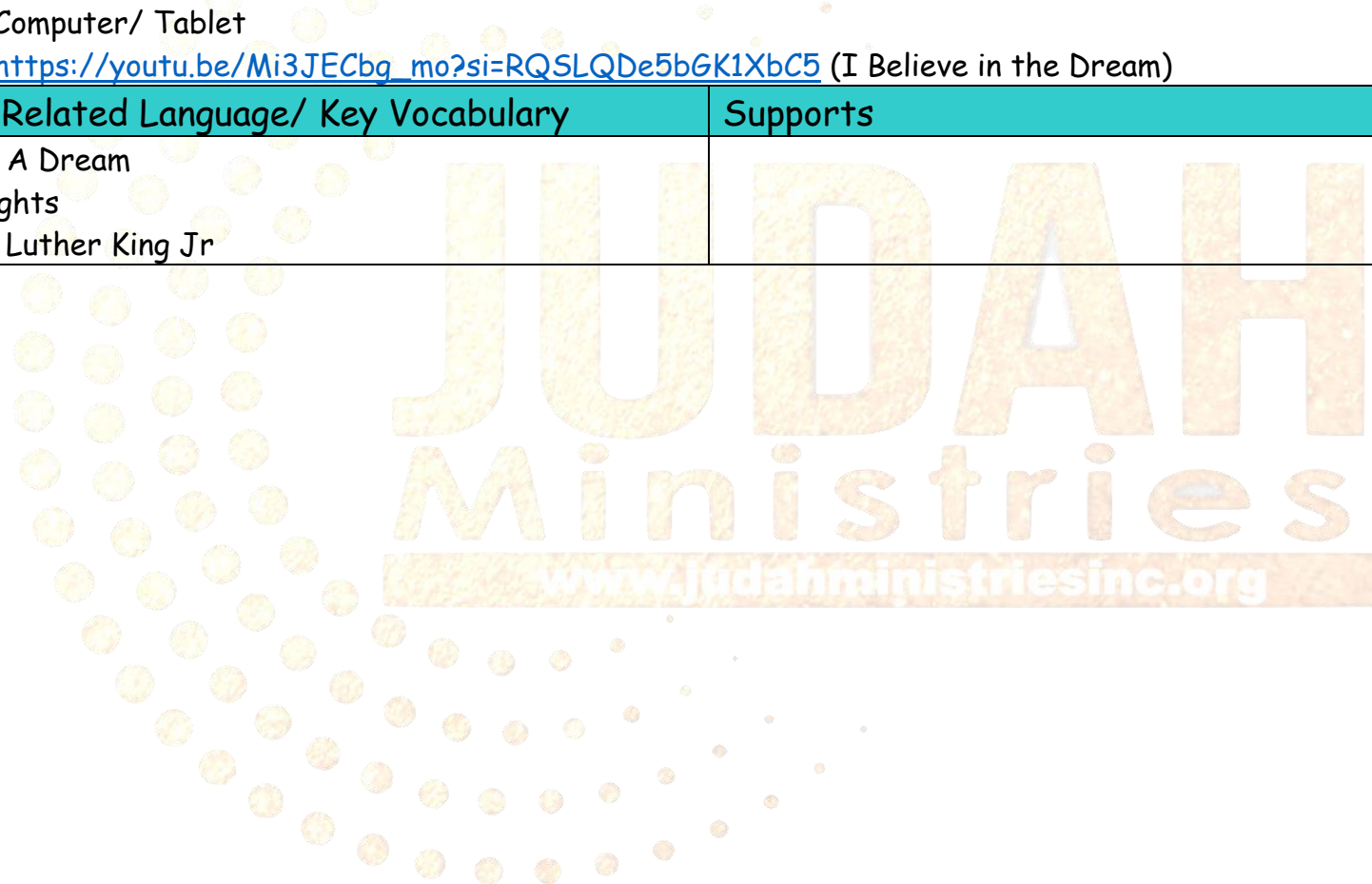

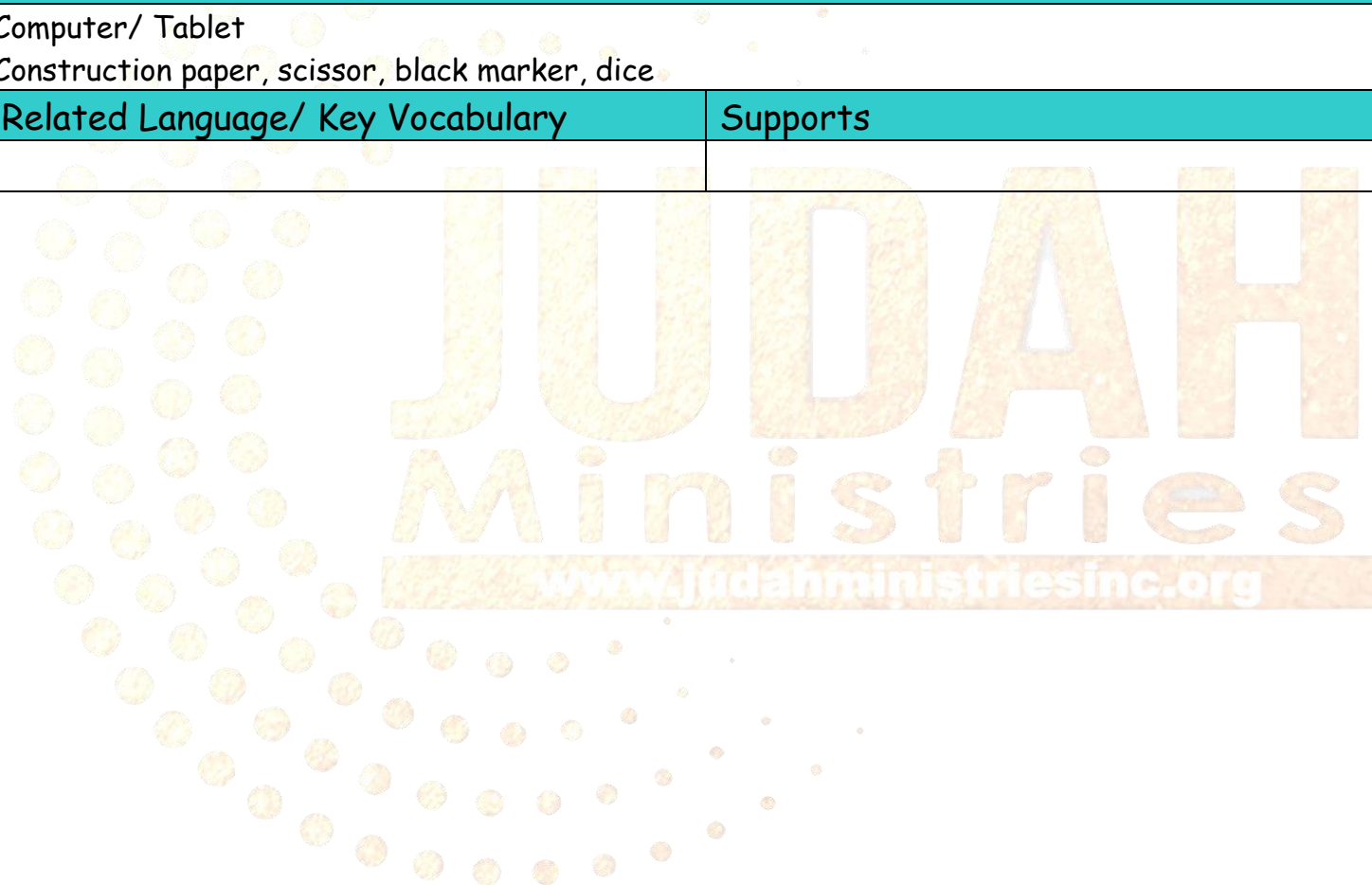
