



programs are the Food Pantry that is offered every week to anyone that comes and signs up for the program. Homeless Initiative helps 328 families monthly with receiving clothing, food, employment help, and other resources.

Clothe-A-Child is a program that sponsors over 100 children yearly with clothing items whose main caregiver is incarcerated, deceased, or has problems with substance abuse.

We also do yearly giveaways such as:

Diaper Giveaway

(5,000 diapers given away each month),

Coat and Toy Giveaway (2,000-backpacks; 2,000-coats; 2,000-shoes, 2,500-hats, gloves, and scarves were given in 2022),

City Wide Easter Egg Hunt & Bicycle Giveaway

(30,000 Easter eggs, baskets and books; 500 bicycles were given)
Back to School Giveaway
(2,748 backpacks and schools supplies given in 2022).

PrideTown Housing Development

includes programs to address financial literacy, and housing/rental information. In partnership with Peter Dunn, Your Money Line.com provides financial advisors with courses, training, and educational videos on how to manage money, invest assets and plan for one's future. We have also partnered with the Fair Housing Center of Central Indiana (FHCCI) to have quarterly Financial Awareness Workshops. We have currently been able to service 59 participants with these opportunities. During these workshops, we have implemented Crown Financial where participants learn about building emergency savings, pay off credit card debt, pay off consumer debt, adjust budget plan, saving for future, invest wisely, and leaving a legacy.
