Watch as the teacher crinkles blue paper close to them and listens to the sound.		Attempt to reach for, grasp, and crinkle the blue paper independently.		



Activities	
<p>The teacher will demonstrate crinkling blue paper, narrating the sensory experience: "Hear the sound? The paper goes crinkle, crinkle!" For younger infants, the teacher will gently crinkle the paper near their hands, guiding their attention to the sound and texture. Older infants will be encouraged to explore the paper themselves by grasping, holding, and crinkling it.</p>

Indicators				
	Infants (0-6 months)		Infants (6-12 months)	
Listen and watch as the teacher plays soothing music, engaging with calming sounds.		React to the music by swaying, cooing, or mimicking the teacher's hand movements.		



Activities	
The teacher will play soft instrumental music (such as lullabies or gentle classical pieces) and gently move their hands to the rhythm, saying, "Let's listen to this beautiful music." Younger infants will observe the teacher's movements and listen. Older infants will be encouraged to mimic hand motions or vocalize along with the music.

	Explore the feel of non-toxic paint with teacher assistance.	Use their fingers to create patterns or marks on paper.



Activities

The teacher will place a small amount of blue, non-toxic finger paint on a sheet of paper, guiding younger infants to touch the paint while narrating: "Feel the cool paint! It's so smooth." For older infants, the teacher will encourage independent exploration, suggesting shapes or patterns while describing their actions: "You're making blue marks with your fingers!"

Resources and Materials

- Non-toxic blue finger paint
- Large sheets of paper
- Protective coverings

Observe the teacher creating a collage with blue shapes and images.		Assist the teacher in placing blue shapes on the collage or using handprints.		



Activities

The teacher will guide infants in creating a simple group art piece inspired by Martin Luther King Jr. The teacher will narrate the process: "Let's make a beautiful dream collage!" Younger infants will observe while the teacher places shapes and textures on the paper. Older infants will actively participate, placing pieces or using their handprints to contribute.

Resources and Materials

- Pre-cut blue shapes
- Large paper or poster board
- Non-toxic glue or tape

Indicators	Infants (0-6 months)	Infants (6-12 months)
	Follow the teacher's actions as they crinkle triangle-shaped paper.	Grasp and crinkle triangle-shaped paper independently.



Activities

The teacher will provide pre-cut triangle shapes of blue paper and demonstrate crinkling the paper, saying, "The triangle makes a crinkle sound!" Younger infants will observe as the teacher crinkles the paper and guides their hands to explore it. Older infants will be encouraged to pick up and crinkle the paper independently, developing motor skills and sensory awareness.

- Pre-cut triangle-shaped blue paper
- Clean play surface
