May Week 1

Theme: Blossom Market

Shape: Rhombus | Color: Teal | Number: 13 | Letter: L

Infants

- Building fine motor skills with drop & place play, sensory bottle exploration, and tummy time with flower toys.
- Exploring books like *Planting a Rainbow* and *A Seed Grows* using picture walks and name repetition.
- Supporting emotional development through bonding songs, mirror play, and family photo connections.
- Engaging with visual and tactile materials in flower-themed exploration and music-based movement.

Toddlers

- Learning about market helpers, flowers, produce, and how we take care of plants through dramatic play.
- Exploring numbers through activities like *Fruit Counting* and *Big & Small* flower sorting.
- Building independence with tasks like clean-up games and recognizing their own job roles in the classroom.
- Participating in creative flower crafts, sponge prints, and freeze dance games to express movement and color learning.

Preschoolers

- Strengthening literacy through flower-themed read-alouds (*Don't Touch That Flower!*, *Planting a Rainbow*).
- Practicing number recognition, measurement, and shape sorting through hands-on activities like *Flower Shop Math* & *Petal Measurement*.
- Exploring how flowers grow through interactive science lessons like *Sink or Float* and *Flower Matching*.
- Building community with dramatic play (*Flower Market*), emotion circles, and helping role badges.

Welcome to Blossom Market Week!
This week, your children will celebrate the beauty of spring by exploring flowers, fruits, and garden growth. They'll interact with hands-on activities using real and pretend flowers, identify the rhombus shape, and practice the letter L and number 13 through movement, sensory exploration, and creative arts.

- Talking about what you see in a garden or flower shop
- Reading books with nature or flower themes
- Encouraging color sorting and naming flowers during walks
- Setting up a pretend flower or grocery shop at home
- Using new vocabulary words like "petal," "market," and "teal"
