May Week 3 Theme: Nature's Backyard Shape: Circle | Color: Brown | Number: 15 | Letter: Nn

Infants

- Engaging with nature visuals and materials through books, toys, crawling paths, and movement.
- Repeating early letter sounds (Nn) and building awareness of new words like "nest" and "nature."
- Strengthening fine and gross motor skills through reaching, crawling, and outdoor bouncing.
 Exploring up and taching and a state in the state of the sta
- Exploring natural textures such as leaves and petals in sensory trays and guided discovery baskets.

Toddlers

- Participating in nature-themed dramatic play and sensory scavenger hunts.
- Singing and moving to the Letter N song and acting out nature animals like birds and bugs.
- Practicing size comparison with big and small leaves and building shapes with natural items.
- Identifying nature helpers like gardeners and caring for toy bugs and plants during clean-up routines.

Preschoolers

- Developing comprehension skills through nature-themed stories such as Outside In and My Friend Earth.
- Using bug visuals and real-world items to explore number 15, circle shapes, and the color brown.
- Building gross motor coordination with bug parades, obstacle courses, and stretch games.
- Engaging in group discussions and nature talks to support vocabulary and expressive language.

Our lessons will focus on interacting with leaves, bugs, sunshine, and soil in fun and developmentally appropriate ways.
