#### Activity: Paint with Sticks

Students will use small sticks instead of paintbrushes to paint on paper.

They will explore different strokes, textures, and patterns the sticks create.

Encourage children to make swirls, zigzags, dots, and straight lines. Afterward, students can share their paintings and talk about how painting with a stick felt different than a brush.
