Activity: Square Creations - Imaginative Drawing with Shapes

The teacher can introduce the concept of using just squares to create a picture. Children will be given paper filled with a variety of square cutouts or printed square outlines and asked to use their imagination to turn them into something—like a house, bug, garden bed, or even a robot. The focus is on open-ended creation and spatial awareness. Afterward, children can describe their square art to the class.
