<b>Day 1</b>	<b>Topic(s)</b> Theme: Sunny Days Ahead Number: 16 Letter: Oo Color: Blue Shape: Rectangle	<b>Foundation(s)</b> <b>APL1.1</b> Demonstrate initiative and self-direction  <b>APL2.1</b> Demonstrate development of flexible thinking during play

	May lift head briefly or reach for nearby toy.	May pivot, crawl, or explore around blanket.
<b>Activity: Picnic Blanket Tummy Time</b> Lay out a checkered blanket with a few toys around the perimeter. Allow baby to move freely during tummy time. Describe the setup as a “picnic” and encourage curiosity.

	Theme: Sunny Days Ahead Number: 16 Letter: Oo Color: Blue Shape: Rectangle	<b>APL1.2</b> Demonstrate interest and curiosity as a learner
<b>Indicators</b>	<b>Younger Infants</b>	<b>Older Infants</b>
	May gaze at, mouth, or bat at items.	May reach for specific textures or explore deeply.
<b>Activity: Weather Basket Play</b> Fill a basket with sensory-safe “weather” items—cotton (clouds), yellow felt (sun), soft blue scarf (sky). Let baby explore each with hand and mouth. Describe each item aloud.

### Activity: **Rolling to Ball**

Gently roll a brightly colored ball just out of baby's reach. Encourage reaching or crawling. Celebrate when they touch or bring it back.

<b>Activity: Pour &amp; Watch Water</b> Fill and pour a small cup of water over a tray while baby watches. Say “Pouring... splash!” Offer repetition and different sounds using slow and fast pouring.
