Activity: Description: Paint Dab

Use a piece of paper and dab bits of paint while the infant watches. Say, "Blue! Tap, tap!" For older infants, use their finger or hand (with assistance) to dab with non-toxic paint. Focus is on watching and gentle exploration, not final product.

Activity: Description: Frog Song

Use a frog puppet to sing or chant a simple "ribbit" rhyme. Move the puppet as you sing and bring it near the infant's hands. Pause to let the infant respond. Great for expression and playful interaction.
