Activity: **Cotton Ball Cloud Art**

Provide blue paper and cotton balls for children to create puffy clouds. Encourage use of glue or tape to attach pieces. Discuss what clouds look like and feel like as they work, building observation and art vocabulary.

Activity: **Watercolor Sky Painting**

Children will paint the sky using watercolors, choosing whether it's a sunny, cloudy, or stormy sky. Play soft instrumental music in the background to promote calm creativity. Encourage movement in their brush strokes as they paint.
