## Activity: Frogs on Lilypads Counting Game

Set up paper or felt lilypads with numbers 1-19 written on them. Provide toy frogs or counters. Invite children to place the correct number of frogs on each lilypad, counting aloud together. Encourage older preschoolers to match numeral cards with the correct quantity or line them up in order. Make it a turn-taking game for group participation.

## Activity: Fish in the Pond Goldfish Graphing

Provide colored goldfish crackers or paper fish cutouts in various colors. Use a simple bar graph mat with columns for each color. Children sort their fish by color and place them on the graph. Count how many fish are in each column. Older preschoolers can compare which color has "more" or "less."

#### Activity: Rubber Duck Dice Race

Set up a simple path with pond-themed spaces. Children roll a large foam die and move their rubber duck forward that many spaces. Count each move aloud. Make it a friendly race with 2-3 kids at a time. Older children can recognize die dots and move accurately, while younger ones focus on 1-to-1 counting and direction.
