Activity: Peek-a-Boo Infants will engage in interactive peek-a-boo play using soft scarves or a teacher's hands. Teachers will use encouraging tone and phrases like "Where did you go? Peek-a-boo!" to support anticipation, memory, and simple turn-taking. This playful interaction builds early social connection and trust.

	Infants may pat or brush textured surfaces with teacher support.	Infants may explore multiple sections, return to favorite textures, or vocalize.
Activity: Texture Board Infants will explore a homemade sensory board with a variety of textures-fuzzy, bumpy, smooth-glued securely in sections. Teachers will label each texture and observe which ones infants return to. This open-ended play encourages focused exploration and tactile curiosity.

Activity: Bubble Play				
Teachers will blow gentle, baby-safe bubbles in front of infants while describing their motion: “Up, up!” or “Pop!” Infants are encouraged to track or try to touch the bubbles, which supports visual development, hand-eye coordination, and open-ended play exploration.

	Infants may focus on the puppet, coo, or smile when it “talks.”	Infants may touch, respond to, or interact with the puppet character.
Activity: Storytelling with Puppets Teachers will introduce a soft puppet (e.g., flower, animal, or garden helper) to tell a short story or sing a rhyme. Infants will observe, interact, and engage as the puppet “talks” or moves. This encourages early social play, attention, and imaginative engagement.
