Indicators	Younger Infants	Older Infants
	Infants may look at or reach toward the letter when shown.	Infants may touch, grasp, or hold the letter with curiosity.
Activity: Touch Letter L Infants will explore large, soft fabric or foam versions of the letter L. Teachers will name the letter slowly, repeating the /l/ sound: “L says /l/, /l/, /l/.” Infants will be encouraged to pat or touch the letter as it is presented and may even mouth or squeeze it during floor play.

	Infants may gaze at or babble toward the card images.	Infants may point, make sounds, or try to mimic words.
<p>Activity: L Object Cards</p> <p>Teachers will present laminated picture cards of familiar objects beginning with the letter L (leaf, lion, light). Each object will be named with clear enunciation, and the beginning sound emphasized: “L-l-lion!” Infants will be encouraged to choose between two cards or reach for the one named.</p>

	Infants may smile, bounce, or coo in response to music.	Infants may vocalize or imitate sounds in rhythm.
<p>Activity: Alphabet Song</p> <p>Infants will listen to the traditional alphabet song sung by the teacher or played gently in the background. Teachers may gently clap hands or tap a rhythm on the infant’s legs or floor mat. Infants will be encouraged to join with body movement or vocal sounds. Teachers will call attention to the letter L when reached in the song.</p>

	Infants may pat or press on the card with hand-over-hand guidance.	Infants may use a finger or crayon to trace with support.
Activity: Trace Big L Infants will trace a large printed or laminated letter L using hand-over-hand guidance from the teacher. For older infants, chunky crayons or textured Ls may be offered to help reinforce shape and stroke direction. The teacher will say the letter and sound while guiding the child's movement.

	Infants may handle or respond to toys labeled with the letter L.	Infants may imitate or repeat sounds while playing.
<p>Activity: L Sound Toys</p> <p>Infants will explore simple toys or plush objects labeled with the letter L (e.g., stuffed lion, laminated label cards). Teachers will reinforce the sound: “L-l-lion!” and observe the infant’s vocal response. Sound imitation will be modeled with smiles and encouragement.</p>
