Activity: **Music Shakers**

Provide infant-safe shakers for exploration. Model shaking them slowly, then faster, encouraging infants to watch and listen. Invite them to copy your movements or clap along. Repeat a short song while using the shakers to connect music with rhythm.

	May touch or smear paint with assistance.	May use fingers to spread paint across paper.
Activity: Finger Paint Silver Offer non-toxic silver finger paint on paper. Let infants explore with their hands, patting, or smearing. Describe their actions: “You made lines, you made dots.” Encourage older infants to use more controlled strokes while exploring the color of the week.

Activity: Dance with Scarves				
Play gentle music and move colorful scarves in the air. Encourage infants to reach, grasp, or wave scarves. Older infants can imitate movements like up, down, or side to side. Emphasize rhythm by moving scarves to the beat of the music.

Activity: **Sponge Paint Hearts**

Provide sponges cut into heart shapes and dip them into paint. Help infants press the sponge onto paper to create prints. Encourage exploration of pressing, lifting, and repeating. Celebrate the creation of heart shapes as a connection to the shape of the week.

	May vocalize or smile during song.	May attempt to repeat sounds or short phrases.
Activity: Echo Song Sing a simple echo song, pausing after each phrase for infants to respond. Start with sounds like “la, la” or “ba, ba.” Encourage younger infants to coo or babble, while older infants may attempt to repeat your sounds. Use hand motions to signal when it’s their turn.
