Activity: Letter S Sound Hunt with Shells

Introduce the letter "S" by showing a sand-filled sensory bin with hidden items (shells, starfish, spoon). Say the /s/ sound and have children search for and name objects that begin with that sound. Encourage older children to try coming up with other /s/ words. Repeat the sound with each discovery to build phonological awareness.

Activity: Shell Letter Match Game

Create "shells" from paper with uppercase and lowercase letters written on them. Lay them out and invite children to match pairs. As each match is made, say the letter name and its sound. Extend the game by asking older children to think of a word that starts with the letter.

Activity: Triangle & Letter Match Tray

Provide trays or mats with triangle cutouts that each display a letter. Say a letter and invite children to find and place a matching object or card on it. This visual and hands-on activity reinforces both shape and letter recognition. Repeat with multiple letters to reinforce learning.

Activity: Coconut Letter Climb Game

After reading *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom*, invite children to "climb" letters up a coconut tree chart. Each child selects a letter and places it on the tree. Use this game to review letter names and connect letters to the story. Older children can build parts of their name or the full alphabet sequence.

Activity: Magnetic Letter Match Game

Set up a magnetic board with scattered letters. Ask children to find matches or place magnetic letters on letter cards. Older preschoolers can be encouraged to try spelling simple CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words like "sun" or "hat." Reinforce left-to-right directionality and letter recognition as they play.
