Activity: Yoga - Peaceful Pose Practice

Guide children through basic yoga poses with soft music and gentle breathing. Use calming visuals or a story to guide movements (e.g., "stretch like a palm tree"). Discuss how their bodies feel before and after. This introduces tools for calming down and managing energy.

Activity: Bubble Play with Calm Music

Blow bubbles in a quiet space while calming instrumental music plays. Encourage children to watch and gently pop the bubbles without running. After play, sit in a circle to talk about how they feel. This activity promotes mindfulness and emotional regulation.

Activity: Emotion Matching Cards

Show illustrated emotion cards (happy, sad, angry, etc.). Ask children to match a card to how they feel or to a story scenario. Discuss how to handle each emotion, such as deep breaths when angry or talking when sad. This builds vocabulary and emotional understanding.
