#### Activity: Cotton Candy Puff Paint in Ziplock

Place pastel-colored puff paint inside a sealed ziplock bag. Tape it securely to a table or floor mat. Encourage infants to press, pat, and smear the paint through the bag to watch colors move and blend, keeping the activity completely mess-free and taste-safe.

#### Activity: Ferris Wheel Art in Ziplock

Draw or print a Ferris wheel outline on paper with the center and "seats" ready. Place small dots of paint in each seat, then seal the page inside a ziplock bag. Encourage infants to press and smear the paint to fill the seats, creating colorful "rides."
