Activity: Dance				
Hold infants securely and sway gently to soft music. Move in big, slow circles, narrating “We’re dancing in a circle!” Encourage older infants to bounce or sway with you, supporting rhythm, early body awareness, and positive feelings around movement and music.

	May follow ribbons with eyes as they wave.		May bat or grab at ribbons.	
Activity: Ribbons Wave soft, colorful ribbons in slow circles above infants, saying “circle” as you move them. Let older infants hold or grasp the ribbons with supervision, encouraging exploration of textures and cause-and-effect as they move their hands.

	May touch or press on textured materials.	May pat or rub hands back and forth.

Activity: Texture Art

Tape textured papers like bubble wrap, sandpaper, or fabric onto the floor during tummy time. Guide infants' hands over the textures, narrating what they feel: "This is bumpy. This is soft." Point out any circular patterns on the materials, saying "circle" to reinforce the week's shape.

Activity: Shakers				
Play music and shake maracas or large rattles to the beat. Move shakers in circles while saying “circle shake!” Let older infants hold and shake instruments with assistance, promoting rhythm, motor skills, and cause-and-effect understanding.

	May look at the caregiver’s face while singing.		May coo, babble, or bounce along.	
Activity: Sing Rock				
Hold infants close and sing a simple lullaby or familiar song, rocking gently in circular motions. Emphasize T sounds if possible (e.g., singing “tick-tock” songs). For older infants, pause for them to babble or imitate sounds, encouraging early vocalization through music.
