Activity: "Who Works at the Fair?" Chart Discussion

Show pictures of various fair workers (ticket takers, food vendors, ride operators). Create a chart and list their jobs. Discuss how each worker helps the fair run smoothly and how they interact with visitors.

Older Preschool Challenge: Choose one fair job and explain why it's important for visitors.

Activity: Fair Helper Job Role Play

Set up a dramatic play fair booth with tickets, play money, and food props. Assign children roles and encourage them to act out fair jobs. Discuss how workers help and follow rules to keep visitors safe and happy.

Older Preschool Challenge: Work in pairs to solve a pretend problem (e.g., a ride breaks or a food item runs out).

Activity: Map the Fairgrounds Together

Create a simple map of a fair on large paper. Include rides, booths, and animal areas. Invite children to place stickers or draw where each should go. Discuss why certain things are placed in certain areas.

Older Preschool Challenge: Create a path on the map to visit 3 places in order.

Activity: "My Favorite Fair Memory" Sharing

Invite children to share a memory about going to the fair or a similar event. They may bring a photo or draw a picture to show the group. Discuss how memories can be special and how sharing helps us connect with others.

Older Preschool Challenge: Ask a friend a question about their memory to practice conversation skills.
