Activity: **Share the Scales**

Inspired by *The Rainbow Fish*, children will practice sharing shiny paper “scales.” The teacher will hand each child one and encourage them to pass it to a friend. Younger toddlers may need support to give the scale, while older toddlers will share more independently. The class will celebrate each act of sharing. This introduces kindness and responsibility in a group setting.

Activity: Give a Fish to a Friend

Children will role play fishing and then giving their fish to a friend. Younger toddlers will practice the physical action of passing the fish, while older toddlers may say “Here you go” or “Your turn.” The teacher will encourage positive language and highlight how giving builds friendship. This activity reinforces citizenship and community belonging.

Activity: Boats and Water Pictures

Children will look at simple photos of boats on water. The teacher will describe what boats do and where they go. Younger toddlers will identify the boats in pictures, while older toddlers may say “boats go on water.” The teacher will connect this to fishing and travel. This activity helps children learn about people and places in their community.

	May point to a picture that shows “yes” behavior.	May say why the behavior is good.

Activity: Picture Rule Chart

The teacher will create a chart with pictures showing classroom rules (sharing, helping, waiting). Younger toddlers will point to or match rules when prompted. Older toddlers may say why the rule is good (e.g., “Wait turn”). The teacher will reinforce that rules help everyone feel safe and happy. This activity introduces community rules in a visual, simple way.

Activity: Trade Fish Game

Children will practice trading fish toys with friends. The teacher will model giving one fish and receiving one back. Younger toddlers may need assistance, while older toddlers will begin to trade on their own. The teacher will encourage children to use words like “please” and “thank you.” This activity develops sharing, cooperation, and citizenship.
