Activity: Count Ride Tickets

Give children paper tickets and numbered ride cards (1-5). Have them place the correct number of tickets on each card. Say the numbers together as tickets are placed. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Count tickets backward from 5 to 1.

Activity: Sort Animals by Size

Provide toy animals of different sizes. Have children help sort them into size categories. Talk about which animals are bigger or smaller. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Line animals up from smallest to largest.

Activity: Ferris Wheel Match

Display a Ferris wheel board with numbered carts. Give children number cards to match to the correct cart. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Count out the correct number of "passengers" (counters) for each cart.

Activity: Dice Spins

Children roll a die, count the dots, and spin a small toy that many times. Encourage them to say the number aloud. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Roll twice, add the numbers together, and spin for the total count.
