Activity: Letter Cc Songs

Sing simple songs that repeat the /k/ sound, such as "C is for Cat." Hold up a large letter Cc card while singing. Encourage infants to clap or tap to the rhythm. Older infants may try to imitate the /k/ sound.

Activity: Cc Picture Cards

Show large cards with simple Cc objects (cat, cup, cookie). Say each word slowly, emphasizing the /k/ sound. Encourage infants to watch your mouth as you say the words. Older infants may attempt to repeat or imitate the sound.

Activity: Texture Tracing - Letter Cc

Provide sandpaper or felt letters for infants to touch. Guide their hands to trace the big Cc shape. As they trace, repeat the sound /k/. This multisensory approach helps infants connect touch with sound and symbol recognition.

Activity: Cc Puzzle Play

Infants play with oversized alphabet puzzles that include the letter Cc. Teachers guide them in placing the letter into the correct slot. Say the sound /k/ each time the piece is placed. This activity builds fine motor skills and early letter recognition.

Indicators	Younger Infants May grasp or mouth the objects.	Older Infants May point to or name familiar Cc items.

Activity: Cc Object Basket

Provide a basket filled with safe objects beginning with Cc (cup, cloth, car toy, crayon). Allow infants to explore the items. As they hold or point, the teacher repeats the object name and emphasizes the /k/ sound. This activity strengthens vocabulary and letter-sound awareness.
