	May repeat the /v/ sound after the teacher.	May name one word that starts with /v/.

### Activity: Letter Vv Sound

Show the letter Vv and make the /v/ sound, exaggerating the lip vibration. Invite toddlers to touch their lips while making the sound to feel the vibration. Show picture cards of items starting with /v/ (van, vest, vegetables) and say the words together. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Name one additional /v/ word not shown on the cards.

	May match one animal sound to its picture.	May match several animal sounds to pictures and name the animals.
Activity: Animal Sound Match Play animal sounds from a device or make the sounds yourself. Show matching animal cards and invite children to guess which animal is making the sound. Encourage them to mimic the sounds. <b>Older Toddler Challenge:</b> Name one other animal that makes a similar sound.

	May clap along to the beat of the song.		May sing or say the /v/ words in the song.	

**Activity: "V is for Very" Song**

Teach toddlers a short song with repetitive /v/ words (e.g., "Very, very violet vest"). Clap or tap a drum to keep rhythm. Encourage them to say or sing along. **Older Toddler Challenge:** Help create a new /v/ sentence to sing.

	May place one V picture in the correct pile.	May sort multiple cards into V or Not V groups.

Activity: V vs. Not V

Show a pile of mixed picture cards and help children decide if each one starts with /v/. Place them into "V" or "Not V" baskets. Say each word slowly to emphasize the beginning sound. **Older Toddler**

**Challenge:** Count how many V words are found.

	May join in on part of the chant.		May say the chant with the group and add hand motions.	
Activity: Vv Sound Chant  Teach toddlers a short, rhythmic chant using /v/ words ("V v v, very, very, van!"). Repeat several times while adding claps or stomps. Encourage children to join in and move their bodies to the beat. <b>Older Toddler Challenge:</b> Add a new /v/ word to the chant and perform it with actions.
