### Activity: Music & Movement - "I'm a Little Scarecrow"

Teachers will sing the scarecrow version of "I'm a Little Teapot," bouncing younger infants gently and encouraging older infants to clap, sway, or raise arms like a scarecrow. Teachers may add props like a scarf hat or straw arms to make the song more visual. This promotes rhythm, body awareness, and connection through music.

#### Activity: Shape Scarecrow Craft (Guided Placement)

Teachers will provide pre-cut shapes for infants to help build a scarecrow picture. Long thin yellow rectangles will be used for "hay" hair, while other shapes (squares, rectangles, circles, triangles) will form the scarecrow's hat, body, and face. Younger infants will enjoy touching or patting the shapes as teachers model placement, while older infants will be encouraged to place shapes on the paper with support. Teachers will glue the shapes down after the child places them. This activity introduces shapes and textures while encouraging fine motor exploration and participation.

Resources/Materials  • Pre-cut paper shapes (long thin yellow rectangles for hair, circles for face, rectangles/squares for body and hat, triangles for details)	Key Vocabulary: shape, rectangle, circle, triangle, scarecrow, hair	Support:

#### **Activity: Ribbon Dance**

Teachers will play soft autumn music and wave colorful ribbons in front of infants. Younger infants will track the ribbons with their eyes, while older infants will grasp ribbons and wave them with support. Teachers will guide children to move ribbons up, down, and side to side. This activity develops visual tracking, motor skills, and musical rhythm.

### Activity: Texture Art - Straw & Fabric Collage

Teachers will prepare sticky contact paper for infants to explore. Infants will touch, pat, or press textured items like soft straw (sealed), fabric, and paper shapes. Younger infants will focus on sensory touching, while older infants will press items onto the sticky paper to make a collage. Teachers will name each texture as children explore.

Teachers will sing or play a simple children's song while encouraging infants to clap, bounce, or sway. Younger infants will enjoy being held and moved to the beat, while older infants will try clapping or swaying independently. Teachers can repeat key words in the song and model simple motions.
