	May listen or become alert when hearing new sounds.	May imitate or repeat simple sounds after an adult.

Activity: Soft Gg Sound Play

Sit face-to-face with infants and softly model the /g/ sound ("guh, guh, guh"). Emphasize mouth movement and invite them to watch your lips. Use short, rhythmic repetition and smile when they respond. Encourage sound play by alternating "go," "good," and "grow." This builds early awareness of sounds in language and develops listening focus.

	May look for a sound source when hearing it.	May respond to familiar sounds like a voice, shaker, or bell.

Activity: Listening Game

Play a short listening game using gentle sound makers like bells, shakers, or crinkly paper. Let infants hear the sound, then pause to see if they turn or move toward it. Repeat several times, switching between sounds and tones. This helps infants develop auditory discrimination and sound recognition.

	May look at or touch objects when named.	May attempt to repeat or vocalize the beginning sounds of familiar words.

Activity: **Gg Object Basket**

Prepare a small basket with safe objects or pictures that begin with the letter Gg (grass, glove, green toy). Present one item at a time, saying its name slowly and clearly: "Grass starts with Gg." Encourage infants to touch or hold the item as you repeat the /g/ sound. Reinforce language by describing color, texture, or shape while keeping tone warm and calm.

Activity: Echo Game

Engage infants in a playful call-and-response activity. Say short, fun sounds such as "goo," "ga," and "gee," and pause to let infants respond. Exaggerate facial expressions and make it a game of sound imitation. Repeat often throughout the day, especially during diapering or one-on-one playtime, to reinforce listening and vocalization skills.

Activity: G Flashcard Exploration

Show infants a large, textured or brightly colored letter G flashcard. Trace the letter with your finger as you say "G says /g/." Allow infants to touch and explore the card while repeating the sound several times. Provide positive reinforcement for any vocalization or movement that mimics participation.
