Activity: Family Photos Talk

Place 3-4 large family photos where infants can see and touch. Name one person at a time and pair the name with a warm gesture like a wave. Invite infants to point, pat, or hold a photo briefly while you echo their sounds and expand with simple words. Compare two photos to notice same and different people and places. Close by letting each child choose one photo and you label the person again.

Activity: Mirror Play with Caregiver

Sit with a safe floor mirror angled for easy viewing. Greet the child by name and wave to the reflection, then label features like eyes, nose, and mouth. Model one or two expressions and invite the infant to try, using hand-under-hand as needed. Pause for vocal play and echo any sounds you hear. End by saying bye-bye mirror to signal a smooth transition.

Activity: Community Helper Pictures

Show 2-3 large helper photos such as farmer, nurse, or builder and pair each with a simple place card like farm, clinic, or construction site. Name the helper and the place in short phrases and model matching by sliding the helper to the place. Offer turns for infants to touch or move a card with your support. Repeat the names together and celebrate any attempts to point or vocalize.

Activity: Gentle Sharing with Soft Toys

Seat two infants near you with two identical soft toys. Model my turn and your turn while gently passing the toy and praising calm hands. Invite the infants to pass to you first, then to each other, using a simple cue like ready, pass. Narrate the sharing and waiting you see to build understanding. Finish with everyone placing toys in a basket together.
