Activity: Open Center Exploration

Reopen favorite October centers (Farmer Market, Construction, Garden, Pumpkin Patch). Invite children to choose where to start and what they want to try. Teachers observe focus, turn-taking, and how children use materials in new ways. Close with a quick share: "What did you try today?"

Activity: Challenge Stations

Set 3 quick challenges: build a bridge for a toy, sort leaves by size, and move 10 blocks with tongs. Model thinking aloud ("This didn't work- what else can we try?"). Children rotate, try, and talk about what helped them succeed.

Activity: Imagination Rewind

Invite children to act out a favorite pretend-play from October and 'rewind' or change one part. Offer props and encourage new endings or roles. Children draw themselves in the scene and tell what changed.
