Activity: Finger Paint: Black & White Spots

Teachers will tape white paper to a tray and offer black, non-toxic finger paint. Infants will explore smearing and patting while teachers describe the colors as "cow spots." Older infants may stamp large spots with a sponge or their palm. Teachers will name "black," "white," and "spots" during exploration.

Activity: Feather Painting (teacher-assisted)

Teachers will provide large feathers and a small tray of yellow paint. Adults will guide infants to drag the feather gently across the paper or pat it to make prints. Older infants will repeat motions and look at the marks they create. Teachers will label actions and colors as they work.

Activity: Yellow Handprint Stamp

Teachers will gently guide infants' hands into washable yellow paint and press them onto paper. After lifting, adults will show the print and name "duck, yellow hand." Older infants may press again to make more prints, building repetition and fine-motor awareness.

	May touch or squeeze soft textures with curiosity.	May pat or press materials onto sticky paper and notice different feelings.

Activity: Soft Texture Collage

Teachers will prepare sticky contact paper sections and place large pieces of fabric, cotton, and feathers nearby. Infants will be encouraged to touch and press each item onto the surface. Adults will describe textures as soft, fluffy, or smooth. Older infants may pull and re-stick materials to explore cause and effect.

Activity: Farm Song Dance

Teachers will play familiar farm songs ("Old MacDonald," "Baa Baa Black Sheep") and encourage movement. Infants will clap, wave, or bounce to rhythm with adult help. Older infants will imitate animal motions (flap, crawl, wiggle) as teachers sing. Smiles and sounds are reinforced as creative expression through movement and music.
