	May explore black and white paint with brushes or hands.	May stamp or dab paint to create cow spots and describe what they see.

Activity: Cow Spot Sponge Painting

Teachers will model dipping a sponge in black paint and stamping spots onto white paper. Children will explore the texture and enjoy creating large spots. Older toddlers will use words like cow or spot and show their paintings to peers. Teachers will display artwork for class appreciation and name each child's contribution aloud.

	May glue or press large feathers onto paper.	May arrange feathers, name colors, and describe what they are making.

Activity: Feather Collage

Teachers will give each child large feathers and a sheet of paper with glue spread thinly by an adult. Children will press feathers to stick them down. Teachers will talk about the colors and texture, encouraging phrases like soft feather or red feather. Finished pieces will be shown during circle time for peer appreciation.

	May make a handprint with teacher assistance.	May help press and lift their hand to make a duck shape and add simple features.

Activity: Yellow Handprint Duck

Teachers will guide each child in painting their hand yellow and pressing it onto paper to make a duck print. Once dry, older toddlers will add a pre-cut orange beak and eye sticker. Teachers will describe each step aloud and celebrate children's efforts.

	May glue large cotton balls to paper.	May arrange cotton to fill the sheep shape and talk about soft or fluffy.

Activity: Cotton Ball Sheep Craft

Teachers will provide a simple sheep outline and demonstrate dotting glue and pressing cotton balls onto it. Children will press cotton gently and describe it as soft or fluffy. Teachers will guide older toddlers to fill the body area, helping develop fine motor control.

Teachers will provide coloring sheets of farm animals (cow, duck, chicken, sheep). Children will use jumbo crayons to color freely. Teachers will name colors used and talk about each animal. Older toddlers may say cow black or duck yellow while showing their page.
