Activity: Faces of the Farmer (emotion cards)

Teachers will display large photos of a smiling farmer and animals. Infants will look at the faces and listen as the adult names the emotions ("happy farmer," "happy cow"). Older infants may pat the happy face when asked. Adults will mirror the emotion back to reinforce connection and recognition.

	May watch pictures shown and smile at bright or familiar colors.	May reach for or point to the "helper" picture when prompted.

Activity: Who Helps? (farmer picture peek)

Teachers will show a simple photo sequence: farmer feeding animals, cleaning, driving tractor. Adults will narrate each action and use consistent helper language ("The farmer helps feed the animals"). Older infants will lift flaps or peek under cloths to find the helper picture.

Activity: Family Animal Pictures

Teachers will show photos of animal families mother duck and ducklings, cow and calf. Adults will say, "Mama duck and baby duck," while pointing to each. Older infants may pat the baby animal photo when asked. This encourages recognition of relationships and family bonds.

Activity: Gentle Hands with Animals

Teachers will model gentle touch with a soft plush animal and say, "gentle hands." Infants will have a chance to touch or pat the animal softly. Older infants may repeat the motion when cued. Teachers will reinforce soft touches by smiling and naming "gentle."

Activity: Review: Farm Helper Photo Book

Teachers will review the week's photo cards and assemble them into a soft photo book. Infants will sit on laps and turn thick pages with support. Adults will label each page ("Farmer helps the cow," "Duck swims"). Older infants may help turn pages and point to their favorite picture.
