Use the "Dragon Beginning Sounds" worksheet. Review letter names and sounds shown on the page. Model saying a picture name slowly, emphasizing the first sound (e.g., "fish, /f/"). Children circle the letter that matches the beginning sound for each picture, saying the sound as they work.

Children clap the syllables for each picture, then dot or color the circle that matches the number of syllables.

Review the sounds for Mm, Nn, Oo, and Pp. Set out four letter cards and a mix of picture cards from December themes (gingerbread, reindeer, winter animals, holidays). Children say each picture word, listen for the beginning sound, and place it under the correct letter.
