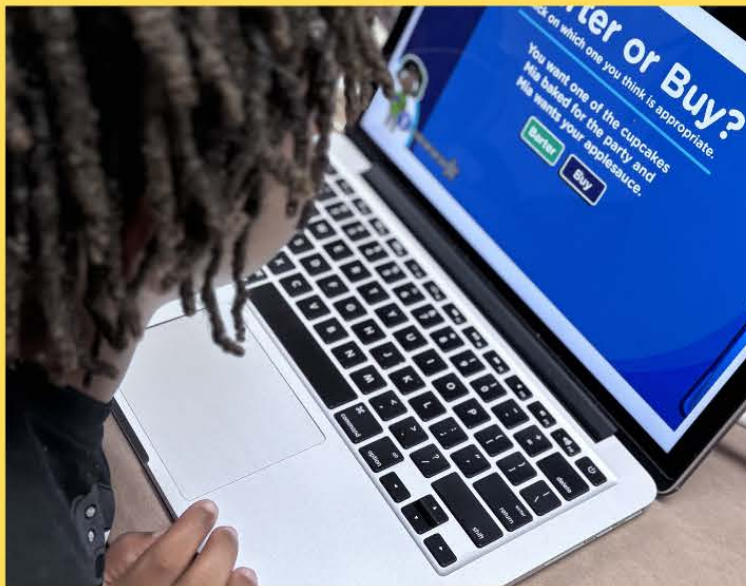

Young Bankers Club: Learning the Language of Money

Our Young Bankers Club campers spent the week exploring the fundamentals of financial literacy through hands-on activities, games, discussions, and real-world scenarios. Students learned how money works, why saving is important, and how wise financial decisions can impact their future.

Student Participation Statistics:

- 100% of campers participated in financial literacy activities.
- Students practiced creating weekly budgets using simulated income and expenses.
- Campers identified more than 50 examples of needs and wants through interactive group exercises.
- Students established personal savings goals and discussed strategies for reaching them.
- Participants completed financial literacy workbook activities focused on saving, spending, and giving.

Drumline Class: Finding Rhythm, Confidence, and Teamwork

Campers also participated in our exciting Drumline Program, where they learned percussion techniques, rhythm patterns, and performance skills while developing teamwork and self-discipline.

Skills Students Practiced:

-  Basic Drum Strokes
-  Rhythm Recognition
-  Tempo and Timing
-  Group Performance Techniques
-  Listening and Coordination Skills

Drumline Statistics:

- Campers participated in group rhythm exercises and performance drills.
- Students practiced multiple rhythm patterns and cadence sequences.
- Participants improved hand-eye coordination through percussion activities.
- Campers worked together in ensemble exercises, promoting teamwork and communication.
- Students demonstrated increased confidence while performing in front of peers.

By participating in both Young Bankers Club and Drumline Class, campers developed skills in:

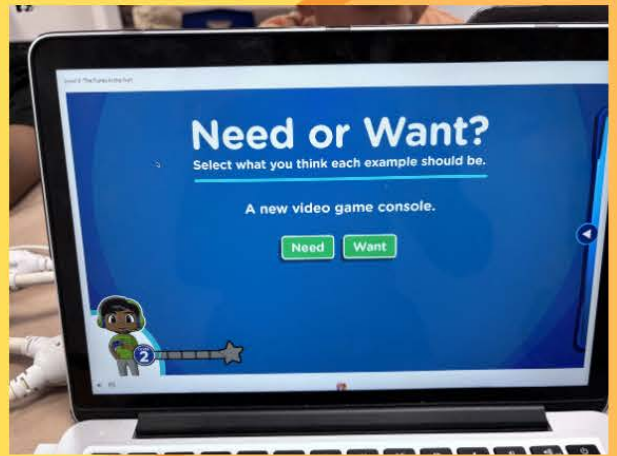
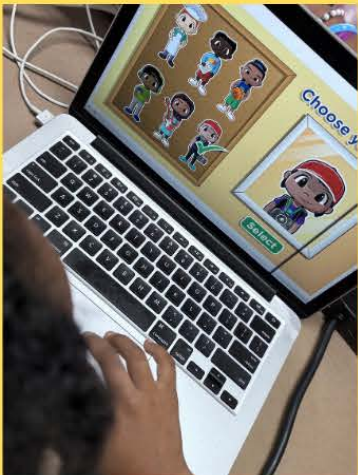

What Students Learned

Throughout the week, campers engaged in age-appropriate financial literacy lessons that focused on:

- Understanding the difference between needs vs. wants
- Learning how to create and follow a budget
- Practicing smart saving habits
- Exploring how banks work
- Understanding checking and savings accounts
- Learning about entrepreneurship and small businesses
- Counting money and making financial decisions
- Understanding the importance of credit and responsibility
- Learning how jobs, education, and careers connect to income

Students participated in mock banking activities where they earned "camp dollars" for positive behavior, teamwork, attendance, leadership, and participation. Campers then used their earnings to practice budgeting, saving, and spending wisely during classroom marketplace activities.
